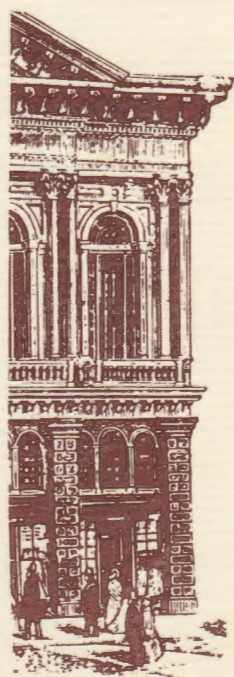
DETAIL FROM ORGAN FACADE - MECHANICS HALL, WORCESTER, MASS.

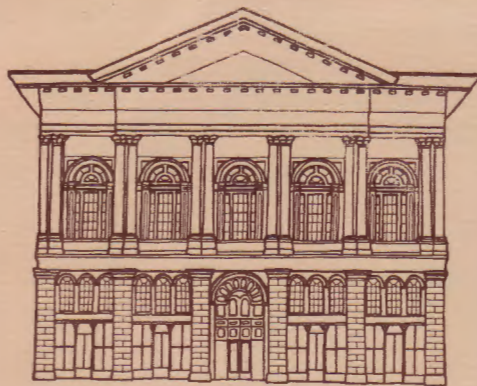
